

Inspired by the natural beauty around her, Caren Heine began showing as a professional artist at the age of 13. Her passion to portray botanical subjects has made her one of the most sought after flower painters in Canada. Her knowledge of plants and skill in portraying them has brought her recognition from the world of commercial art as well, and she has done a number of commissioned works for the advertising industry. In the year 2000, the Royal Canadian Mint featured Caren's design of the Pacific Dogwood on a limited edition gold coin' one of a series depicting the provincial flowers of Canada.

Caren and her father, the late Marine artist Harry Heine, have conducted painting tours for many years, to such exotic locales as Bali, Turkey, and most of Europe. This year the tradition continues with a trip to Egypt in February 2006. Teaching abroad, or in workshops in B.C. and Alberta have become a delightful way to share her love of painting with others.

Some galleries displaying Caren's originals are The Gallery at Oak Bay, Butchart Gardens, and Art Works in Fort McMurray, where she currently resides.
